Steampunk as a digital humanities practice of repurposing reacts to the growing sense of multiple non-human temporalities mediating our human histories: microtemporal electricities flowing through our computer circuits, mechanical oscillations marking our work days, geological stratifications and cosmic drifts extending time into the millions and billions of years. Excavating the entangled, anachronistic layers of steampunk practice

from video games like *Bioshock Infinite* to marine trash floating off the shore of Los Angeles and repurposed by media artist Claudio Garzón into steampunk submarines, *Steampunk and Nineteenth-Century Digital Humanities* uncovers the various technological temporalities and multicultural retrofutures illuminating many alternate histories of the digital humanities.
